

Care Instructions for LUSSO MISTO Italian Cashmere

Cleaning:

We highly recommend professional dry cleaning to maintain the quality and extend the life of your cashmere . Dry cleaning should be done by a reputable service experienced with luxury fibers.

Freshening Up:

To freshen your blanket between cleanings, air it outdoors on a dry, overcast day. Avoid direct sunlight and damp conditions.

Drying:

If your blanket gets damp or wet, lay it flat on a clean, dry towel. Roll up the towel, pressing gently to absorb moisture. Unroll and lay flat to dry on a fresh, dry towel. Avoid hanging or using direct heat as it can stretch and damage the fabric.

Storing:

Store your cashmere blanket folded in a cool, dry place. Avoid hanging as it can deform the shape of the blanket. Use natural moth repellents such as cedar or lavender sachets for long-term storage to protect against pests without damaging the fibers.

General Care:

Avoid using harsh chemicals, bleach, or fabric softeners that can damage the cashmere fibers.

If pilling occurs, gently remove pills with a cashmere comb or professional de-pilling tool.

Using a Cashmere Comb:

Lay your cashmere blanket flat on a clean, smooth surface. Gently stretch the area of the blanket where pilling has occurred.

Hold the cashmere comb flat against the fabric and carefully brush in one direction.

Use short, gentle strokes to remove pills.

Collect the pills after combing and dispose of them.

Repeat the process as necessary, being careful not to over-comb, as this can damage the fibers.

Regular combing can help maintain the blanket's smooth texture and appearance.
